IAA Dress Code Policy 2024-2025

IAA has a dress code for all students. All students **must wear** the official school uniform with the school logo <u>preferred</u>. Refusal to adhere to the school dress code, will result in the student being sent home. The student's parent/guardian will be notified of the student not complying with the dress code and will need to be picked up. Failure to comply will result in the following:

- Students <u>will not be admitted to class</u> until a parent or guardian has reported to school and has provided their child with appropriate clothes identified in IAA's dress code policy.
- The student will remain in the refocus room until the parent/guardian arrives.
- If the school has items the student is missing, the student may sign out the items needed and return them at the end of 7th period that day so they can be washed. The items will come from our school closet.
- If not returned, the parent or guardian will receive an invoice for the amount to replace the item or items loaned out to the student. If the student still doesn't comply, the student will have to go home for the day.

High School

Shirts/Tops: Must be a solid, heather gray colored collared shirt with the <u>school logo</u>, <u>preferred</u>.

Pants/Bottoms: Must be khaki, black, or navy colored chino pants, shorts, or skirts. Skirts and shorts should fall two inches above the knee or longer. No jeans, tights, or sweatpants.

Sweaters/Pullover: solid heather gray sweater or cardigan, or fleece with <u>school logo</u>, preferred. This year the school will allow heather grey quarter zip, crewneck pullovers, and plain hoodie with no logo unless it is the school logo.

Shoes: Any color sturdy sneakers or dress shoes. No open toe shoes, steel tip boots, sandals, slides, flip flops, or slippers.

ID And Lanyard: School issues ID cards and Lanyards must be worn at all times. Replacements are \$3.

Dress Down Days: the shoes and Lanyard requirements remain intact every day. No leggings, yoga pants, stretch pants, clothing with inappropriate designs / sayings which would be inappropriate in school, no ripped or torn clothing that show skin, and no half shirts or tank tops. Hat, wave caps, or another item to be worn on your head is not allowed unless for religious reasons.

Middle School

Shirt/Tops: Must be a solid, navy blue colored collared shirt with the <u>school logo</u>, <u>preferred</u>.

Pants/Bottoms: Must be khaki, black, or navy colored chino pants, shorts, or skirts. Skirts and shorts should fall two inches above the knee or longer. No jeans, tights, or sweatpants.

Sweaters/Pullovers: Solid, navy blue sweater, cardigan, or fleece with <u>school logo</u>, <u>preferred</u>. This year the school will allow solid navy colored quarter zip, crewneck pullovers, and plan hoodies with no logos unless it is the school logo.

Shoes: Any color sturdy sneakers or dress shoes. No open toes, steel toed shoes, sandals, flip flops, slides, or slippers.

ID And Lanyard: School issued ID cards and Lanyards must be worn at all times. Replacements are \$3.

Dress Down Days: The shoes and lanyard requirement remains intact everyday. No leggings, yoga pants, stretch pants, clothing with inappropriate designs / sayings which would be inappropriate in school, no ripped or torn clothing that show skin, and no half shirts or tank tops. Hat, wave caps, or another item to be worn on your head are not allowed unless for religious reasons.

Consequences for Dress Code Violations

- **1st Offense:** If a student refuses to comply with the dress code policy, the parent or guardian will be notified to pick the student up and the student will be sent home, unless the parent can get the student to agree to wear the appropriate dress code item.
- 2nd Offense and subsequent offenses: Will result in being assigned to the reflection, refocus room, and/or suspended out of school. A parent meeting will need to be scheduled to resolve the issue. If a student consistently doesn't follow the dress code policy, a referral for expulsion will be sent to the CEO/Principal and the Board of Trustees.

All sweaters, pullovers, and hoodies must be solid colored heather gray for high school and solid colored navy for middle school. All other colors and or clothing worn with logos, other than the school's logo, will have to be kept in the students locker.

If seen with these items, throughout the day, they will be confiscated. If a student continues to have issues with these items, a parent will be requested to come to the school to address the issue. Items confiscated will be returned to the student at the end of the day. These items will be stored in either the School Store or the Dean's Office.

Clothing Prohibited: Do Rags, Hoodies, Bandanas, Hats, Blankets, Sunglasses inside the building, Slides, Clothes with holes / rips / tears, any pant color other than Khaki, yoga pants, and Crop shirts (overly exposed clothing). These items are not permitted on the school bus and/or the school premises at any time.
