Middle And High School Incentive / Reward Trips 2024-2025

Reward / Incentive Guideline

- 1) The reward and incentive program will utilize the KickBoard positive point system to make students eligible for the activity that month. Just because the student has the appropriate point value, doesn't mean the student automatically goes on the trip. It is strictly a starting point, the highest points at the time of the trips will be given the choice to participate or not.
- 2) The points students earn will be awarded to them from the Cougar Bucks behavior system in Kickboard. As students go above and beyond, teachers will be required to reward those students with positive points that are predetermined in the kickboard program. Both High School and Middle School Teachers are to use this system.
- 3) Students should be educated on the system and what they are working for by displaying appropriate behavior in class. The positive point rewards are critical for students if they are to meet the required limit to be eligible for a trip.
- 4) The deciding factors that will eliminate students, even if they have made the minimum point requirement, will be school behavior and attendance.
- 5) School Attendance for each months activity with need to be between 85-100%
- 6) Also if a student has been suspended out of school or been assigned to the refocus room consistently, they are eliminated regardless of the points they have earned for that month's activity.

- 7) Mr Rush will run a <u>monthly</u> report on student attendance prior to the activity going out. Any student below 85% will be removed from the list regardless of behavior. Mr Rush will use discretion for students with health concerns.
- 8) Tracking sheets will also need to be completed and be up to date. There needs to be a way we track OSS and ISS. If a student receives either or both, they will be removed from the activity list.
- 9) All off ground trips during school hours will require a signed **Permission Slip** from the student's Parent or Guardian. Failure to return the permission slip will result in that student being removed from the trip.
